Today with the entire Church, we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. On Trinity Sunday, we celebrate the mystery of God’s inner life: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. These are not three separate gods, but God in three persons. This is unity in diversity and diversity in unity.

Every prayer, religious activity or prayerful gathering we begin and conclude with the profession of the Holy Trinity. The sacraments are performed in the presence of the Holy Trinity. The existence of the Holy Trinity is from the beginning. Everything is created through the command and power of Trinity.



The scripture tells us that God is all-loving, faithful and forgiving by nature. He opposes sin and evil with just wrath and right judgement, and He approaches sinful people and evil doers with mercy and fatherly correction.

Trinity is not just a doctrine; it is a mystery to be adored, lived and shared. It is the mystery of Wisdom, Truth and Love. Wisdom comes from the heart of God; Love is poured into our hearts by the Spirit; and Jesus tells us that He is the truth. We are part of their love, and their life of wisdom, truth and love, which they share with us.

Saint Martin of Tour says, “Trinity Sunday also invites us to reflect on our own lives. We are called to live in communion, to make ourselves a gift to others, and to participate in the life of love that flows from the Father to the Son and the Holy Spirit”.

On this feast of the Most Holy Trinity, God calls us into an intimate relationship of love, which makes us His own daughters and sons. He has made us, saved us and He sends us to be a part of His salvific plan. He demands of us to share the same love with others who are still in darkness and bring them to the light of the truth.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end, Amen. Blessings of the Most Holy Trinity! Fr. Robin
